The benefit becomes available after completing the Health Check.

Unlocking the WELLTH Fund

To unlock the WELLTH Fund, all members on the DHMS policy, aged two years and older, must have completed their relevant, in-person Health Check any time from 01 January 2022.

Once *all the members on the membership* have completed their Health Check, they will have access to a combined, single WELLTH Fund allocation depending on the size and age of members on the policy:

- R2,500 per adult (18 years and older)
- R1,250 per child (over the age of 2 years old)
- Up to an overall maximum limit of R10,000 per policy.
