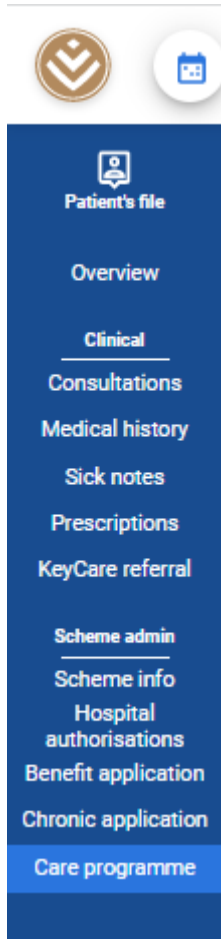

How does the Care Programmes Dashboard work

- To get to the member's Care Programmes dashboard, find the Care Programme menu item in the patient's file:



- Click Manage on any active Care Programme to enter the dashboard:



- For each Care Programme the member is registered on, an accordion will be present. Each accordion displays different information based on the programme type:

- Diabetes Care

Under the Diabetes Care accordion, we display:

- All Diabetes related Chronic Illness Benefits the member has with a quick link to the CIB management page
- The Diabetes Management Score
- The member's Focus Area
- A list of key metrics related to the Diabetes Care programme
 - o If a metric is severely out of range, the reading will be red
 - o If the metric is at risk, the reading will be orange
 - o If the metric is within range, the reading will be green
 - o Metrics that do not have an acceptable range will remain black
 - o Any metrics we do not have on record will display "N/A"

The 'End programme' button found in the Care Programme management page can be used to opt the member out of any Care Programmes they have. Diabetes Care, Cardio Care and HIV all need to be ended at the same time, while Mental Health Care can be ended separately.
